4th South Asian Diaspora Convention (SADC) to Identify Growth Opportunities Through Innovation in South Asia

Singapore, 12 November 2019 – The 4th South Asian Diaspora Convention (SADC) will return to Singapore from 15-17 November 2019. Hosted by the Institute of South Asian Studies (ISAS) at National University of Singapore, the convention is themed *Vibrant South Asia – Innovative Diaspora* and is expected to bring together more than 800 distinguished guests and more than 30 of the region's leading policymakers, business leaders, academics and civil society leaders as speakers. Singapore's Senior Minister and Coordinating Minister for National Security, Mr Teo Chee Hean, will deliver the keynote address at the inaugural session on Saturday, 16 November 2019, followed by an interactive session with participants.

A welcome gala dinner will precede the convention on Friday, 15 November 2019. The evening will witness the honouring of a distinguished member of the South Asian Diaspora. Launched in 2013, the Outstanding Member of the South Asian Diaspora (OMSAD) Award recognises the award recipient's outstanding lifetime achievements, which have left an indelible mark on his or her field as well as on society-at-large. Past award recipients include Mr Murli Kewalram Chanrai in the 2013 and the late former Singapore President, Mr S R Nathan in 2016.

This year, the Special Lifetime Achievement Award is introduced for the first time and will also be presented on the evening of the gala dinner. The Special Lifetime Achievement Award recognises an individual for his or her significant contributions in his or her field of profession. Mr Tharman Shanmugaratnam, Senior Minister and Coordinating Minister for Social Policies, Singapore, will be the Guest-of-Honour for the gala dinner reception and will present these two awards that evening.

On Saturday, 16 November 2019, the full-day convention will consist of seven sessions that cover various geopolitical and economic topics pertaining to South Asia and its diaspora. The sub-themes include:

- Business in South Asia: Opportunities and Challenges
- Infrastructure and Smart Cities
- Innovation, Start-ups and Youth
- Women Empowerment in South Asia
- South Asian Diaspora: A Strategic Asset?
- Technology in Financial Services
- Trends in Education Technology

This year, we have introduced a session on women empowerment in South Asia, which brings together several female political leaders and change makers in one session. Ms Indranee Rajah, Singapore's Minister in the Prime Minister's Office and Second Minister for Finance and Education, will deliver her keynote address for this session.

Also gracing the event is Mr Lawrence Wong, Singapore's Minister for National Development and Second Minister for Finance. He will deliver his keynote speech and participate in an interactive session for the plenary on Infrastructure and Smart Cities.

These sub-themes have been carefully chosen in view of their current significance to South Asia and how the South Asia diaspora can contribute in these areas. As the SADC is held in Singapore, a key element of the event is how Singapore and Singapore corporates and organisations can also be involved economically in some of these key areas.

The convention will reinforce Singapore's position as a hub for international commerce and business connection and entrench Singapore's position as a global thought leader. More specifically, Singapore serves as an important node for business networking amongst the South Asian diaspora as well as between the diaspora and business communities in East Asia and beyond. The convention will provide participants an opportunity to forge binding relationships that will enable them as a community to participate in the rapid growth of a resurgent South Asia.
